There are limited spaces for each activity and places will be allocated on a first come, first-served basis. **Please ONLY book your child's first choice on Scopay.**

Details further details regarding payment schedule will be provide once we confirm your child's place on their activity. If you do not keep up with the payments, this may result in your child's space being reallocated to those on waiting lists. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium, we may be able to contribute towards further payments; Please contact the school accounts department to discuss this. All monies paid are non-refundable once tickets and activities have been secured and paid for, except in exceptional circumstances.

Activities Day is a chance to celebrate the hard work that staff and students have put in all year. It is a privilege rather than a right. As a school, we would love to celebrate with all of our students but we reserve the right to withdraw a place on any activity if pupils have not contributed positively throughout the year or if we believe that they may not follow instructions at an off-site activity (putting themselves and others in danger).
