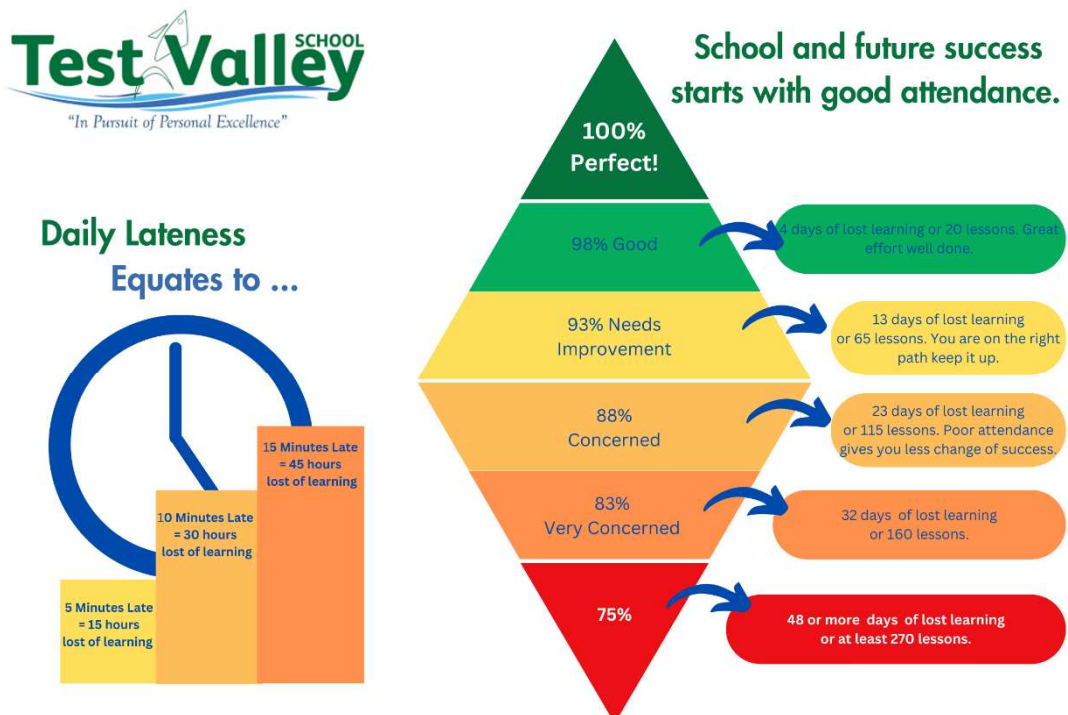
Dear Parents/Carers,

This term has flown by, faster than I can every remember! We've managed to pack lots of work in during lessons and during opportunities to learn beyond the classroom. Mrs Mckeown, SLT and I have been pleased with continued positive changes in behaviour and attitudes, personal development, and the quality of education over the last term. With each term that passes our culture grows stronger and stronger, we are immensely proud of our wonderful pupils and staff.

As a result of the improvements across the school and the relationships we've built, we are welcoming more students to our school each week. Over the last 2 weeks we've welcomed 9 new pupils and toured prospective pupils and parents around the school with a view to joining us after Easter. Our new members of the TVS community come from all over the world, even as far afield as New Zealand! It's so exciting to bring such a wide range of cultures together and learn from each other. It is with great sadness that we said goodbye to Mrs Whitehead yesterday. She has supported so many children over the last 17 years in so many ways, she will be missed by so many. We wish her lots of love and luck.

'Understanding and Supporting your child with Low Mood' workshop

Further to the successful pilot of our parent workshop: 'Understanding and Supporting your child with Low Mood' in September 2023, we are looking to roll this out further as part of our Whole School Approach offer. As a service we will be offering this workshop digitally once per term for any parents/carers who you feel may benefit.

The workshop will be mostly informative, with some optional opportunities for discussion, input and questions via the digital chat function.
