- Gold year 12 – Expedition 4 days 3 nights – 16 places
- Finish Gold you go to the Palace to get your award

Three simple ideas

- Volunteering
 - After school club or youth group
- Physical
 - Get an app on your phone and cycle or walk and get someone outside of the family to check you have done an activity once a week
- Skill
 - Learn to cook, get your neighbour to sign off you have cooked a meal a week for the family and washed up!!!!

- First Aid Kit



- Trangia (stove) & Gas



- Maps and Compass



Your equipment

- Rucksack (can be loaned)



- Waterproofs



- Non cotton clothes



- Walking boots – not trainers



- Walking socks



- Sleeping bag



Minimum – Combinations (Bronze)

- Volunteering 3 months
- Physical 3 months
- Skill 6 months

- Volunteering 3 months
- Physical 6 months
- Skill 3 months

» or

- Volunteering 6 months
- Physical 3 months
- Skill 3 months



Fees

- The cost is £140 for Bronze for the year
