Reading

All Key Stage 3 pupils have begun to take their STAR reading tests this week, in preparation for beginning the Accelerated Reader programme. The tests give pupils an indication of their reading age and something called a Zone of Proximal Development. This is a reading range that helps pupils to choose books within their optimal reading ability range. Doing this will help pupils to develop their vocabulary knowledge and comprehension of texts further. The more that pupils read, the better they will become! More information will be published on this in the coming weeks, as well as a session on reading in the Year 7 Parent Information evening on Thursday 10th November.

As well as the tests this week, Test Valley also welcomed our new Librarian, Mrs Eloise Hopewell. This exciting news means that we will very soon be able to reopen our library and have lots of exciting reading opportunities for our pupils.
