Dear Parents and Carers,

Strike Action

The NEU are planning two further days of industrial action on Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July. It is possible that negotiations between the union and the government may avoid this action, however, we need to plan for it.

On Wednesday 5th July school will be open to Year 10 students only and on Friday 7th July to Year 9 only.

We have decided to prioritise Year 10 because they are in the middle of their GCSEs, with only 34 school weeks left until their final exams, it's crucial they are in school for face to face lessons. Year 9s have also been prioritised as they are about to embark on their GCSEs.

On both days students who aren't in school will be set work on Microsoft Teams, unless their teacher is striking. This will also be visible on ClassCharts should students not be able to access Teams.

We may be able to offer provision for a small number of students from other year groups if absolutely essential, either because a child is vulnerable or because the parent and carers job is categorised as 'critical'. Please email us at office@testvalley.hants.sch.uk by Monday 3rd July 3:30pm if you would like your child to Attend at the latest. If your child is entitled to free school meals, they can collect this from the school canteen during break time.

We've had another busy week in school, a highlight was welcoming our new students who will be joining us in September. Tuesday was induction day, students all came together for breakfast, met their tutors, attended a range of lessons and got to know each other. It was lovely to see so many happy faces at the end of the day. On Wednesday evening we welcomed our new Year 7s back, along with their parents and carers, there was a lovely feel to the evening, I'd like to thank our awesome Transition Buddies and Senior Prefects for helping out on the evening, along with our Year 11 band, 'Out of the Valley' who performed a few songs for us, they were brilliant!

Key Stage 3 started the week with a bang! They all took part in RE workshops to debate the relevance of faith in the 21st Century. We were incredibly lucky to have three external presenters, two of whom were 'Rappers', the students enjoyed this immersive and engaging experience.

A group of avid readers attended the Hampshire Book Awards on Thursday, I'm told our students were very vocal and shone when they were asked to debate the books with students from all over Hampshire, go #TeamTV!

Raising aspirations has been at the heart of our assemblies and trips this week, we've had a number of guest speakers into explain post 16 pathways, along with a group of students visiting Peter Symmonds College for their taster days. Year 10 were truly inspired when they returned. Thanks to Mr Langdown for providing so many opportunities for our young people.

I've just been up to the top field to watch our students taking part in the 'Colour Fun Run'. As I write I can still hear lots of laughing and cheering from our students taking part, it's music to my ears!
