PUPIL

- wear the school uniform and be tidy in appearance
- complete all my classwork and home learning tasks as well as I can
- behave reasonably and responsibly and follow the Code of Behaviour and the Rights Respecting School Charter
- be polite and helpful and show respect to others as well as respecting the rights of other pupils and adults
- resist from any form of bullying, harassment or discrimination
- respect the school environment, keeping it free from litter, graffiti and damage and use of mobile phones procedures.
- abide by the school's Social Networking, ICT and Use of Mobile Phones procedures
- represent the school according to the Code of Behaviour when I am in school uniform and on school trips.
