Dear Parent,

On the Thursday 18th December all Year 11 pupils will be taking part in an enterprise day entitled 'Millinery Magic'. Pupils will work in teams as the managers of a business company. The purpose of the activity is for pupils to gain an understanding and appreciation of how businesses have to work within a competitive and collaborative market.

As the title suggests the chosen business revolves around the fashion industry and transforming existing hats into more creative, attractive and fashionable headgear. The day will cumulate with a fashion parade to promote their own company's products. Therefore, each team of pupils will need to provide a hat that can be altered and materials to renovate their appearance.

Dress Code:

The dress code for the day is dependent on the role that you son/daughter will be playing:

- Finance Director – smart office/business dress
- Project Director – smart office/business dress
- Creative Director – working clothes, suitable for handling glue etc.
- Promotions Director/Model – smart office/business dress for morning activities, but pupils should bring a change of clothing for their role as a model in the fashion parade. This should complement the theme and style of the hat but still comply with the ethos of our school dress code i.e. no inappropriate body exposure. Pupils will be allowed to change into this outfit during the later part of their lunch break.

Teams will need to provide:

- One hat per team
- Materials to decorate the hat taking into account the concepts of Recycle, Repair, Refuse, Reuse, Reduce and Rejuvenate. (therefore, the expectation is that pupils should avoid purchasing materials specifically for redecorating their hat).
