

Arrangements for Duke of Edinburgh's Award Navigation Challenge

Dear Parent

Welcome to the DofE Award, your child's first excursion will take place on Saturday 22nd November. Teams start in two different locations. Please see the map attached for specific details. I would like to draw your attention to the fact that travel arrangements are the responsibility of parents and I would be grateful if you could ensure that your child is dropped off and picked up on time.

Time -The activity will start at 09:00 and finish at the <u>same location</u> at 13.00.

Programme

The purpose of the walk is to introduce basic map skills, the country code and stamina awareness in preparation for greater independence during the next, more challenging, event.

Equipment - Each participant should carry;

- 65 (+ or 5) litre ruck sack.
- Packed lunch including a drink.
- Sleeping bag.
- Complete change of clothing including trainers.
- Waterproof coat.
- o Hat.
- o Gloves.

Candidates should wear walking boots & warm clothing dependent upon the weather conditions.

Permission -

In order that your child can take part in this activity I require your permission in writing. I would be grateful if you would complete the attached form and return it to the school office at your earliest convenience.

Directions to start and finish – 22nd November 2014 – 9am to 1pm <u>SAT NAV quick directions</u>

Locate the Royal Oak Public House, Fritham, New Forest = SO43 7HJ.

Teams 1, 2, 3 & 4 travel past the Royal Oak and green area before turning left down a track to the car park.

Teams 5, 6, 7 & 8 travel past the Royal Oak and on up the road between woodlands until you locate a track on your right just before a lake. The car park is a short distance up this track.

More detailed directions

The drop off/pick-up point is the same. Fritham in the New Forest is found via West Wellow heading NE towards Salisbury. You will drive into Plaitford. Look out for the BP garage on your left and turn left immediately after the garage.

Follow this road to its end and cross over the B3079 heading into Nomansland. Soon you will cross over a cattle grid. Continue through Nomansland and out the other side along a narrow winding road until you reach the end.

Carefully cross the B3078 heading towards Fritham and Stoney Cross. At the end of this short stretch of road bear right. Take your next right turn, sign posted Fritham, & Eyeworth, a short distance around the corner from this junction.

Locate the Royal Oak Public House someway down this narrow lane and follow the directions to the appropriate car park for your team as detailed in paragraph two or three above.
