
Dear Parent

Guidance notes on reports

Attitude to learning grades

Targets

- The level a pupil has the potential to achieve with consistent hard work.
- End of Year and Key Stage Targets are given as split National Curriculum Levels, as examples, 5A indicates a high level 5 and 6C indicates a low level 6.
