The Spring Term is an important time for all Year 9 pupils as they look ahead to their Key Stage Four curriculum and are able to select some of the courses they will follow in Years 10 and 11. We guide pupils fully through the different pathways they can take and offer as much information and individual support as possible to help them make the right choices.

The programme of events for this term is listed below, including those we would like to invite parents to attend so you are able to support your child fully in this process:

Wednesday 25th February: Year 9 Futures Day in school for all Year 9 pupils.

This event is an opportunity for all Year 9 pupils to attend a range of interactive workshops on 14-19 choices and decision making. The workshops will be hosted by staff and representatives from local colleges.

Monday 2nd March 6.15pm - 8.00pm: Year 9 Pathways Evening for Year 9 pupils and parents. This event is an opportunity to:

- find out how the different curriculum pathways work
- talk to Heads of Department about the Key Stage Four courses they offer
- find out more about the post-16 opportunities and requirements

Wednesday 18th March: Key Stage Four Choices Booklet issued to all Year 9 pupils. This booklet contains full details of the courses and the pathway routes into Post 16 education.

Monday 23rd March 4.30 – 7.30pm: Year 9 Parents' Consultation Evening.

This event is an opportunity for parents to meet with their child's individual subject teachers to:

- discuss their child's progress in each subject
- discuss possible subject choices for Key Stage Four

Week starting Monday 23rd March: All Year 9 pupils will have a 1-to-1 meeting with their tutor to guide them through the Key Stage Four curriculum choices and the right pathway for them.

Week starting Monday 30th March: All Year 9 pupils to return their completed Key Stage Four Curriculum Choices Forms to school.
