Guidance notes on reports

Attitude to learning grades

- These range from 1 (exceptional) to 5 (very poor). An Attitude Grade of 3 implies the pupil is working as expected.
- For detailed descriptors visit www.testvalley.hants.sch.uk, and search for *attitude grade descriptors*.

Current grade

- The GCSE grade a pupil is currently working at.

Prediction

- The final GCSE grade a pupil is predicted to achieve if they continue to work in the way they are currently. Green/Red indicates meeting/not meeting Target grade.

Target grade

- The GCSE grade a pupil has the potential to achieve with consistent hard work.

Comments

- Staff now have the option of writing a comment to guide particular pupils as to where their focus should be over the coming term.
