

Year 8 Pupil Monitoring Data

Dear Parent

The Pupil Monitoring Data for Year 8 pupils is now live and parents can access reports for their children through their Moodle Parent Account. Please request a parent account via the school's website if you have not already done so. Assessment information has been provided for each subject, broken down in to a series of assessment areas. Details of age-related expectations (ARE) are available on the school's website. Pupils have started to make progress towards the ARE for each subject as follows:

Abbreviation	Description	Descriptor
Ex	Exceeding	The pupil is consistently exceeding ARE with little need for support and guidance
S	Securely Meeting	The pupil is consistently meeting ARE and/or occasionally exceeding with support and guidance
D	Developing	The pupil is making progress towards ARE but sometimes requires support and guidance
Em	Emerging	The pupil is starting to make progress towards ARE but requires continued support and guidance

Please note that all ARE assessments are predictions for the end of year outcome, i.e., what each pupil is expected to achieve at the end of the year if they continue to make progress at the current level.

Some of the assessment areas will be blank as these areas have not yet been taught. In addition, progress towards the ARE might appear to be slower in some subjects due to the nature of the subject itself. Please refer to the attitude grades for a further indication of how well your child is doing. Some teachers have provided a target for improvement which is shown beneath the assessment information for their subject.

Finally, I would be grateful if you would acknowledge the Pupil Monitoring Data for your child by returning the reply slip below to your child's tutor by **Tuesday 12 December 2017**.
