Dear Parent

The Chairs of our Governing Body recently wrote to inform you of my decision to resign as Headteacher.

As you will understand this was a very difficult decision to make, having been Headteacher through many changes and challenges over the last ten years. I will miss the school very much but my decision is because of family circumstances at this time.

The local authority, in liaison with the Governing Body, have been working hard to organise interim arrangements until a new Headteacher is appointed at a later stage. These have been finalised this week, giving me the opportunity to therefore step down from half term. I appreciate this is very soon but do believe this is the right decision for my family and the school.

I would reassure you that the interim arrangements will ensure the school is able to go forward in safe hands. The Chairs of the Governing Body will be writing to you separately to confirm the arrangements to be in place from Monday February 24th. I would also remind you that on this day and Tuesday February 25th we have staff training days, therefore pupils are due to return to school on Wednesday February 26th.

Finally, I would take this opportunity to thank you for your support. It has been my pleasure to meet and work with many of you whilst Headteacher. I send very best wishes for the future to you and your families.
