Dear Parent / Carer,

In line with the Government guidance, we would like to invite your child in school for some key lessons in order to support their learning at this crucial time.

The lessons will be in English Maths and Science. They will run from 9.30am - 12.45pm every Tuesday and Thursday starting **Tuesday 9th June**.

Pupils will need to be in school uniform please.

Your child will need to enter school through the main gate near the bus bays and walk down and register in the hall. There will be markers on the floor to denote 2 meters. We would ask your child uses these to ensure social distancing.

During the day your child will have three taught lessons by specialist teachers. These will all be based in one room in the main block. Tables and chairs will be set up to ensure that social distancing can happen effectively.

Your child will need to bring their own equipment - pen and pencil, as these cannot be shared in class. They will also need to bring drinks and snacks as no food will be available to buy.

As mentioned in the communication sent earlier this week, our behaviour policy sets out clear expectations with regards social distancing:

The school will endeavour to implement all DfE and HCC advice on social distancing to ensure the safety of pupils and adults in school. Pupils are expected to adhere to necessary adjustments and take individual and collective responsibility for adhering to these measures without negotiation.

The School does not permit inappropriate physical contact in school. Pupils are expected to ensure that they act in a sensible manner and do not engage in activity that could lead to harm. Any behaviour which either through negligence (or wilful defiance) of the social distancing measures which causes potential harm to others will be treated as a serious breach of policy.

We will need to send your child home from school if they are unable to follow these expectations in order to maintain their safety and the safety of others.
