Dear Parents and Carers,

Further to a recent letter about lunch time arrangements (22nd September 2020), please note that from next week you will no longer need to pre-order your child's food.

We will be opening the canteen on Monday 28th September and pupils will be able to get their food during lunch break. You will need to top up your child's account for Monday in order for them to be able to have a school lunch.

We won't be using fingers to pay for the meals, catering staff will look up individual names on the system.

In order to minimise the times pupils are spending around the kitchen, as well as to ensure pupil numbers are compliant with the current distancing regulations, from Monday the times during which pupils will be able to get a school lunch will be staggered as follows:

- Year 7 – 1pm
- Year 8 – 1.05pm
- Year 9 – 1.15pm
- Year 10 – 1.25pm
- Year 11- 1.35pm

The order of entry to the canteen will change on a rota basis.

Pupils entitled to the Free School Meals will be able to collect them from the kitchen hutch at their year group allocated time.
