On Wednesday 6th October, all pupils in years 7-10, will be participating in a PSHE day. The theme for the day is diversity. The outline of the day and the activities included have mainly been **planned by our pupil leadership teams.** We are very proud that they have taken the initiative to organise and run this day.

During the day, pupils will have sessions on disability in sport, the history of Pride, an ambassador event (in which our pupils will lead and talk to other pupils about their experiences around areas of diversity and inclusion), a session in either Art, Drama or Music and a talk by Diversity Role models, this will include a discussion on LGBT+ inclusion in education and the key issues they feel are facing pupils in school today. It will also give pupils the opportunity to reflect on how they can be part of developing the culture of our small, rural high - achieving school to ensure it is as safe and supportive an environment as possible.

PSHE helps pupils develop the knowledge, skills, and attributes they need to manage their lives, both now and in the future. These attributes help pupils to stay healthy, safe and prepare them for life and work in modern Britain.
