If the answer is positive to any of these questions you will be asked to leave the school site. Observe social distancing whilst you are on site. There are markings on the floor and one-way markings in order to help you do this. Visitors to the school site are no longer required to wear a mask when moving around the corridors and other communal areas, or when in closer than 2m contact with anyone. 	Visitors KJ All Staff

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							<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where possible, confine yourself to the designated work area only. • Where this is not possible, limit your travel within the site or building as much as is practically possible and only within agreed areas. Observing the one-way system that is in place across the site. • Increase ventilation in enclosed spaces. • When you walk in to reception you will be asked to sanitise your hands. • Whilst on site please ensure you practise good hand hygiene by washing your hands with soap and water or hand sanitiser for a minimum of 20 seconds, often during your visit, and before you leave site, using the identified facilities on site. • Notify the receptionist before leaving the site.

Likelihood

Severity

- Negligible
- Minor
- Moderate
- Major
- Critical

Risk control strategies

- Intolerable** – stop activity, take immediate action to reduce the risk
- Substantial** - Take action within an agreed period
- Tolerable** – monitor the situation
- Trivial** – No action required
